

## Waukesha Art Crawl 6th Annual Plein Air Art Fair 2024

## **Prospectus and Artist Agreement**

- 1. The painting area is the city of Waukesha; however the preferred painting area is Main Street from The Springs Studios and Gallery/Veterans Park to Barstow Street. Broadway Street from the Fox River to Wisconsin Avenue/Polished Patina and along both banks of the Fox River from Veterans Park to Frame Park/Moreland Blvd. (See map)
- 2. Artists must be respectful of the natural landscape and must remove and clean up all materials.
- 3. Artists may paint any outdoor subject within the painting area. This event is open to artists using oils, watercolors, acrylics, gouache or pastels. Artwork must be executed outdoors; no interior access is permitted; no photographs may be used. Maximum size of canvas is 16" x 20" unframed and 24" x 28" framed.
- 4. The plein air is limited to the first 25 paid registered artists.
- 5. Each work must be started and completed between 10am Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup> to 10am Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Check-in and canvass stamping at Almont Gallery is required prior to any work being done. Almont Gallery is located at 342 W Main Street, Waukesha. Check-in and canvass stamping is Monday September 30<sup>th</sup> between 10am 4pm.
- 7. An optional Nocturn event is available to artists as well. Nocturn paintings can be done any evening during the Plein Air, however a special opportunity to paint from the roof of People's Park will be announced.
- 8. Submission of finished works is Friday October 4<sup>th</sup> from noon 5pm AND Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup> from 10am to noon.
  - a. Deliver paintings to the Waukesha Civic Theater located at 264 W Main St, Waukesha.
  - b. Each artist may submit **UP TO** three (3) pieces for the Artists Reception & Sales Event
    - i. One (1) piece must be from the preferred painting area,
    - ii. One (1) piece artist choice, and
    - iii. One (1) piece of a nocturn.
  - c. Each painting should be signed on the front. A Plein Air stamp provided at registration must be visible on the back of each piece.
  - d. All paintings must be appropriately framed, mounted and securely wired for hanging. No saw tooth hangers. Paintings not ready to be hung will not be accepted.
- 9. The Artist will set the price for each piece. The Artists' Name, title of the piece, medium used and price will be provided by the artist on a card provided during the submission of the piece. This card will be displayed with the painting during the Artists Reception & Sales Event.
- 10. Artists will retain all copyright privileges and rights to their work.

- 11. Paintings will be sold at, and Artists should participate in, the Artists Reception & Sales Event on Saturday, October 5th from 5:30 8pm located at the Waukesha Civic Theater, 264 W Main St, Waukesha. The Buyers Reception is taking place as part of the 132<sup>nd</sup> Waukesha Art Crawl, which is held from 2 8pm. The awards will be announced at 6:00pm.
- 12. Artists receive 75% of the selling price during the Buyers Reception. The Waukesha West End Artists (WEA) will receive 25% commission and manage sales/sales tax at the point of sale. A portion of the commission collected by WEA will be used to support ACAP/Art Links.
- 13. Artwork will be judged by up to 3 jurors on Saturday, October 5<sup>rd</sup> between 2 -3pm.
- 14. New for 2024 will be a People's Choice Award with voting taking place from 2-5pm on Saturday, October  $5^{th}$ .
- 15. 6 awards will be given out as follows: **Best in Show** will be awarded \$500, **First Place** \$250, **Second Place** \$150, **Third Place** \$100, **Nocturn Award** \$250 and **People's Choice Award** \$250. Additional honorable mention awards may be given.
- 16. Unsold, non-award winning, paintings can be picked up by the Artist immediately following the Artists Reception & Sales Event.
- 17. Up to seven Award winning paintings will be shown in an exhibit at the Waukesha Civic Theater lobby from October 5<sup>th</sup> to October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 18. Pick up of award-winning paintings will be on Wednesday October 16<sup>th</sup> from noon 5pm at the Waukesha Civic Theater.
- 19. Waukesha Civic Theater will also offer the award winners a featured exhibit in the WCT Waukesha State Bank Fine Art Gallery. Dates for the featured exhibit are January 23 March 12, 2025. Each award winner will be able to exhibit 3 pieces of their choice that meet the size requirements in item 3 above.
